Passion (Palm) Sunday, March 24/25

Reader 1 and Reader 2 maintain their regular Reader duties during mass, with the following addition:

After the second reading, R1 goes to the stand provided where the petitions are read and will proclaim the **speaker part** of the Passion Gospel.

After the second reading, R2 remains at the ambo and will proclaim the **narrator part** of the Passion Gospel.

The Presider or Deacon will proclaim the Jesus part of the Passion Gospel from his chair. The assembly will read the chorus.

Good Friday March 30

Reader 1 and Reader 2 maintain their regular reader duties during liturgy, with the following addition:

After the second reading, R1 goes immediately to the stand provided where the petitions are read and will proclaim the **speaker part** of the Passion Gospel.

After the second reading, R2 remains at the ambo and will proclaim the **narrator part** of the Passion Gospel.

Deacon will proclaim the Jesus part of the Passion Gospel from his chair. The assembly will read the chorus.

Readers scheduled Easter Sunday April 1, use the first option for second reading, Colossians 3:1-4.

Ash Wednesday Minister Instructions

The distribution of ashes will take place after the final blessing.

* Ministers go to the table near the baptismal font for ash bowls immediately after the final blessing.

Presider gives ashes to ministers first.

Last minister may give ashes to Presider.

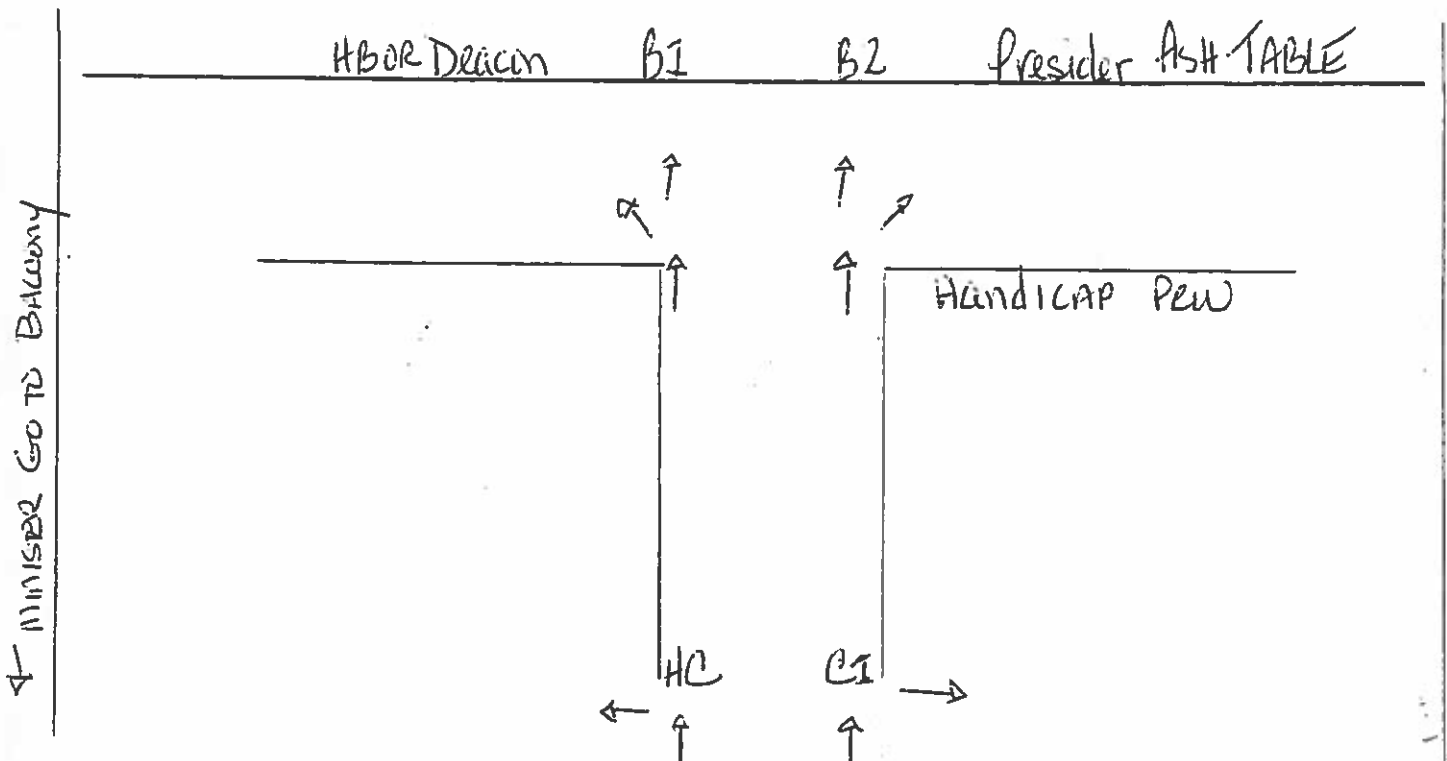
Ministers proceed to designated place to distribute ashes. Ministers in front, please do not stand behind the communion rail. Stand with the communion rail behind you.

Presider gives ashes to handicapped pew first, then proceed to designated place to distribute ashes.

While making the sign of the cross on the forehead say the following:

“Repent and believe in the Gospel.”

Rinse hands at table near font. Return to pew.

Before mass the large palm branches are located on the first step at the sanctuary sides. During the procession when you reach this area place the palm branch back in this place for the next mass and be seated. Be sure the branch is on the step as not to block aisle.
