Old Business

- Eric
 - Mardi Gras – It was a successful event. People gave very positive feedback -enjoyed the food and great environment. Most people saw the hall, etc. It was attended by about 250 people. We will continue next year.
 - Facilities team – Started core team, chaired by Dennis Laudbaum. We are prioritizing facilities projects. One area is fixing the parking lot which is rundown. Working with Dan Leary, civil engineer in tri-valley. Dan provided an Initial estimate cost for our lot: \$300,000 expense. Nothing has been done in last 20 years. His number is conservative, built in contingency dollars. From engineering standpoint, we want him to put it together initially. Does not include plumbing. Paving, asphalt, signage, materials, labor - general assessment.
 - Looking at electrical in the church – Lights going out, switch to new LED. Electrical issues, lighting not working in certain spots.
 - Roof issues
 - Need to replace some plumbing – around \$20k
 - Looking at painting the hall, cleaning out facilities – convent.
 - Freezer just arrived for Hall, to be installed tomorrow.
 - January collection 99% of budget, Latin Mass, 2018 Collection – solid
 - Catholic Charities coming out– Thursday, March 15,
 - Catholic Moms coming, exploring idea of a more formal women’s ministry like Catholic daughters
 - First Welcome Brunch – once a month, on last Sunday of every month. Welcome new families, 6-8 families rsvpd so far. Welcome committee is involved. Sending email out to ministry leaders
- Deacon Dave
 - Chapel next door, serious security issues – getting people who are slightly disturbed. Instructions regarding restroom, lady got scared, woman came in pounding on walls. Phone hooked up. Code will be changed. Met with adoration committee and they are issuing a new security code for those who come bet 9pm-6am. Instructed to call police if stuff happens. They’re having a drive for new people to sign up in the adoration committee.
 - Ash Wednesday – thousands of people attending.

- Centennial follow-up. Meeting with committee follow-up in March. Centennial dinner and mass with Bishop will be the Sunday before. Sept. Worship aid for the mass will be a little more than a normal aid. We can get historical photos and use as a keepsake.
