When approaching the Priest, you are to first bow. Then the

preferred way of receiving the Body is on their tongue

(child/teen is to show how they are to stick out their tongue to receive). This is how every child/teen will receive the very first time. Another way to receive is on their hand (child/teen is to show how they are to hold their hands to receive on the hand and how they take the Body from the hand to their mouth). The child's/teen's right hand should be on the bottom with the left on top. When the Priest places the Body on the child's/teen's left hand, the child/teen is to immediately use their right hand to take the Body and put it in their mouth before leaving back to their pew. The child/teen is to do the Sign of the Cross after receiving the Body
