Occupancy Planning for St. Michael's - Eric Hom

The last site study and capital improvement in the parish was almost 12 years ago. A site study is needed to understand the future needs of the church in terms of facilities. There are newer families coming in. Our parish is growing and the new community in Livermore is going. If it's growing, in 5-10 years, there will be more people and families coming in and we need facilities.

The study will assess population growth, and other factors so we have enough information to assess our future facilities. The study will interview the community and will project housing development. Specific data will be provided to us. The process will take about 1-2 months. The study will be presented to the diocese. We need to be proactive on what is needed in the parish for the future of the parish.

Festival Meeting and Planning
