PRAY THE ROSARY WITH CREATION



In creative celebration of the Most Holy Trinity, pray a rosary with creation. Find a quiet place outside or sit near a window. Contemplate the amazing Divine Gift that is before you. Admire it. Study it. Become one with it. Ask for the guidance of Brother St. Francis as you pray: "You, Holy Father, are King of heaven and earth. You are three in one, God above all gods. You are good, all good, and supreme good, Lord God, living and true. You are love. You are beauty. You are gentleness. You are joy. You are hope and happiness." Admire the wonder and majesty of God in all that is around you. Ask for wisdom and understanding.

Begin each decade with the Our Father and conclude with the Glory Be.

Decade one: Contemplate God the Father. As you pray each bead with a Hail Mary, get lost in the grandeur of all that you see. Imagine the thousands and thousands of years of history that is before you. Envision a time when nothing existed. What is nothing? Lift your eyes, heart, and soul to the power and magnificence of the universe, its

expanse and its endlessness. You are one with it all. God's creative power.

Decade two: Contemplate God the Son. Behold the squirrels, birds, and critters all conducting life's business. They have heartbeats just like yours. Praying each bead, become one with the incarnate divine life that flows through you and flows with the smallest of creatures. It is holy innocence and blessed life. Tenderness. Compassion, Mercy. Reverence. All want to be held, have a home, and be loved. God in all things. Emmanuel.

Decade three: Contemplate God the Holy Spirit. The changing of times and seasons happens often without notice. It is all within God's care and guided. We all belong. Behold the living, dying, and rising to new life. You are one with all time from beginning into eternity.

Decade Four: Contemplate God as One.

Decade Five: Contemplate God as three. All different while remaining one. The divine dance is being danced before you. Rest in what you see. Become what you see.

We are all connected: God of the Holy Trinity, creation, our brothers and sisters, the animals, and the plants.

The rosary you have prayed celebrates the circle of connectedness and the intimate relationship we share with all things: a glimpse of the Trinity.

UP TO THE JOB

Have you ever had a job for which you didn't feel qualified? I think we all have, whether it was a paying gig or not. A lot of us parents often feel in awe of the magnitude of that role and lose sleep worrying that we made the wrong decision in one situation or a bad call in another. Some of us feel intimidated by what our communities need from us, on the parish level or in our personal relationships. Or maybe we are simply dreading a task that seems too big, too overwhelming — that necessary basement cleanout, or the weekly organization of family schedules.

When we don't feel qualified, we don't want to do the work. We get stuck in our own fear. That's the birthplace of procrastination, self-doubt and bitterness. When we look inward at our own abilities, we can only see all the traits that aren't there. The intelligence, the dexterity, the ambition — whatever it is we lack, we get stuck on it.

I've got good news and bad news. I'll start with the bad news: none of us are qualified for the call of discipleship. We simply aren't. We don't have the love or grace or strength to get the job done.

Now I'll give you the good news: God knows this, and He doesn't care. Stewardship does not insist that we possess every good quality — no, as a way of life, stewardship recognizes that we lack so many qualities. But it shows us where to find the love and grace and strength we need.

Stewardship does not demand that we know every answer; it merely reminds us who to ask when we don't.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO



“En el nombre del Padre, y del Hijo, y del Espíritu Santo”. Al santiguarnos, pues, no lo hagamos tan aprisa y balbuceando la oración que nos encomienda a la Trinidad y nos ayuda a comprometernos como bautizados al servicio del Reino de Dios. La Trinidad es un misterio de amor y de entrega, y cada año, la Liturgia nos propone reflexionar en las tres personas que la componen: Dios Padre, Dios Hijo y Dios Espíritu Santo. Es el misterio más grande del cristianismo. Donde Dios se revela como comunidad de vida y de amor que existe en la Trinidad. Un solo Dios verdadero, en tres personas distintas.

“El Señor ordenó bautizar en el nombre del Padre y del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. El catecúmeno es bautizado profesando por ello la fe en el Creador, en el Unigénito y el Don. Solo uno es el Creador de todo, ya que uno solo es Dios Padre, de quien procede todo; uno es

también el Unigénito, nuestro Señor Jesucristo, por medio del cual todas las cosas fueron creadas; y uno solo es el Espíritu, que a todos nos ha sido dado” (San Hilario de Poitiers (315-367) Sobre la Trinidad). “La Santísima Trinidad es la luz del tiempo pascual y de Pentecostés, renueva cada año en nosotros la alegría y el estupor de la fe: reconocemos que Dios no es una cosa vaga, nuestro Dios no es un Dios ‘spray’, es concreto, no es abstracto, sino que tiene un nombre: ‘Dios es amor’. No es un amor sentimental, emotivo, sino el amor del Padre que está en el origen de cada vida, el amor del Hijo que muere en la cruz y resucita, el amor del Espíritu que renueva al hombre y al mundo” (Papa Francisco). ¡Amén!

PREPARADO PARA EL TRABAJO

¿As tenido alguna vez un trabajo para el que no te sentías calificado? Creo que todos lo hemos hecho, ya fuera un trabajo remunerado o no. Muchos de nosotros, los padres, a menudo nos sentimos asombrados por la magnitud de ese papel y perdemos el sueño preocupándonos de haber tomado la decisión equivocada en una situación o una mala decisión en otra. Algunos de nosotros nos sentimos intimidados por lo que nuestras comunidades necesitan de nosotros, a nivel parroquial o en nuestras relaciones personales. O tal vez simplemente estamos temiendo una tarea que parece demasiado grande, demasiado abrumadora: la limpieza necesaria del sótano o la organización semanal de los horarios familiares.

Cuando no nos sentimos calificados, no queremos hacer el trabajo. Nos quedamos atrapados en nuestro propio miedo. Ese es el lugar de nacimiento de la procrastinación, las dudas y la amargura. Cuando miramos hacia adentro a nuestras

propias habilidades, solo podemos ver todos los rasgos que no existen. La inteligencia, la destreza, la ambición, sea lo que sea que nos falte, nos quedamos atrapados. Tengo buenas y malas noticias. Comenzaré con las malas noticias: ninguno de nosotros está calificado para el llamado del discipulado. Simplemente no lo estamos. No tenemos el amor, la gracia o la fuerza para hacer el trabajo. Ahora te daré las buenas noticias: Dios lo sabe y no le importa. La corresponsabilidad no insiste en que poseamos todas las buenas cualidades; no, como forma de vida, la corresponsabilidad reconoce que carecemos de tantas cualidades. Pero nos muestra dónde encontrar el amor, la gracia y la fuerza que necesitamos. La corresponsabilidad no exige que sepamos todas las respuestas; simplemente nos recuerda a quién preguntar cuando no las tenemos.

WITNESS TO LOVE PROGRAM COMING TO ST MICHAEL PARISH **Mentor Couples Needed to Join the Team**

The Witness to Love program is a virtues-based, Catechumenate model of marriage renewal and preparation that integrates modern principles of psychology and the virtues to help couples facilitate an authentic dialogue about their relationship. What makes this program unique is that the engaged couples (and couples married civilly who are seeking a sacramental marriage) are partnered with a married mentor couple. The two couples meet for about four-six months to complete the course, pray together, and celebrate Mass together.

Led by David and Lisa Hipple, nine-year veterans of the Oakland Diocese marriage prep ministry, the Witness to Love program will transform St Michael Parish into a wellspring of dynamic marriage discipleship that fosters both parish connection and nurtures authentic accompaniment before and after the wedding day.

SHOULD A CATHOLIC PURSUE AN ANNULMENT?

Question: After a civil divorce, is a Catholic obligated to pursue an annulment?

Answer: Many Catholics are not exactly sure what an annulment does. An annulment does not deny that a marriage took place, nor does it deny that there once was love. It does not mean that people say anything untrue, such as they never loved each other or that everything in their marriage was wrong. An annulment does not negate children, nor make them illegitimate. An annulment addresses the spiritual aspect of marriage. In effect, an annulment says that at the time of the wedding, there was either something present or something absent that prevented the sacrament from taking place. It is a spiritual determination that, if granted in the affirmative, allows a person to marry in the Church.

Annulments have no legal standing and are unable to be used in a civil court. Therefore, a Catholic has no moral obligation to pursue an annulment. However, when the tragedy of divorce occurs, and there is no hope for reconciliation, annulments may help bring some spiritual closure to a person's life. Some people have found the process to be healing and others have found it to be difficult. Speak to your priest or a member of the Diocesan Tribunal staff to decide what is best for you. 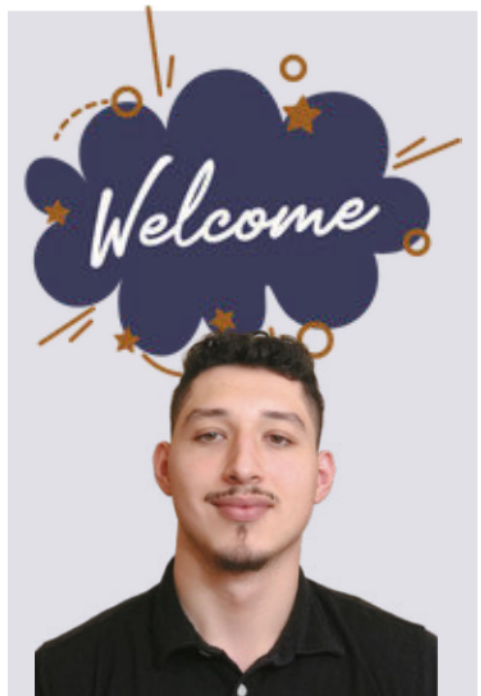
