Ronnie Forbes' #SacredStory



Anyone who meets Ronnie instantly feels his joy for the Lord and his unquenchable passion for helping people in need. His One Nation Dreammakers Veterans Mobile Food Pantry has provided hundreds of pounds of free, high quality food to over 10 cities every week, but it's his infectious laughter and spirit that has provided much more.

But it wasn't always this way. Here's his SacredStory:

Thanks for sharing your story, Ronnie. Tell us a bit about where you started.

I was raised in a very predominantly nondenominational household in southern California. My mom and dad are co-pastors of Riverside Christian Family Fellowship, so you could say that I had a pretty strict upbringing! I went to UC Irvine right out of high school and started running from the Lord and running from my upbringing. I got involved in a lifestyle of doing what I knew I shouldn't be doing. I decided to move to Northern California and to live with my grandmother, to pursue a new life of sobriety. But yeah, it didn't work. I started using and hanging out with the wrong people again, and I had two choices: either to join the Oakland Police Department or to join the United States Army. I chose to join the Army.

Did the Army set you straight?

No, but all the glory goes to God and His patience. I went to Korea with hopes and aspirations of retiring out of the military. I met Korean woman and fell in love with her, and we got married. So many things transpired there that caused me deep pain and trauma. Without getting all in to it, a black man married to a Korean just wasn't being treated like a white man married to a Korean. But I stayed there in Korea for three years before bringing her home. But I also brought with me the alcohol and the drugs that continued while I was in the military, that I was using to self-medicate my PTSD. I hadn't forgiven the military and I hadn't forgiven myself for all of the things that I had done. And I was just in a downward spiral. I blamed God. I blamed the military. I just kept drinking and using, and my marriage fell apart. I left her and all the support of my family and ended up on the streets homeless in Oakland and Hayward. I was hanging out with the wrong crowd and back and forth to jail.

That's often a situation that many say is hopeless. What changed for you?

My moment of clarity was when I was last incarcerated. I heard a voice from God. He said, "Look. You're either going to serve Me behind these walls, or you're going to serve Me outside of these walls. But you will

certainly serve Me." I will never forget it. But it started me on my path to recovery. So, I moved to Livermore not knowing anything about the Tri-Valley, but I came out here to continue in my quest for sobriety. Then I kept thinking about God's message to me, and I knew I was being called to help veterans.

The Lord called to help you too, right?

Yeah. I totally surrendered to Jesus on July 4, 2015. Truly Independence Day! I got the counseling help, the medical help, to help the physical. That's when the hard work of recovery partnered with God's grace made the difference. And He led me to my beautiful new wife, my guardian angel. She's Catholic and goes to St Michael's and she's my anchor.

What did your connection to St Michael's do for you?

I started really feeling the Holy Spirit in the fellowship of St Michael's. Everything just started happening so quickly, meeting everyone there and getting support. The changes in my life with everybody that I connected with at St Michael's... I mean St Michael's will always be headquarters to me. And that's where the veteran's food pantry program took off to another level.

So that's about when One Nation Dream Makers was founded?



Yeah, I had started fellowshipping with other veterans who were struggling like I was. And I kept thinking that this was the Holy Spirit opening doors for me. I formed One Nation Dream Makers to help veterans and those less fortunate get back on track to become positive influences in their families and in their communities. Working in partnership with St Michael Community Care and other agencies and organizations, we started providing hundreds of pounds of free, high quality food to over 10 cities every week. We started delivering the food directly to low-income housing facilities, government housing facilities, schools, churches, and senior citizen centers throughout the Bay Area. Around 1,295 boxes, each containing 35 pounds of meat, cheese, milk, fruits, vegetables and pasta, enough to feed a family of four for a week.

That is quite a full circle!

I am so grateful to serve. I go back to these same places and deliver food that I was receiving from when I was a homeless veteran, out there hungry and standing in some of the

same lines. It just motivates me to do more. If I can help somebody by bringing them food, so they don't have to go shopping, they can take that money to go pay their electric bill or take that money to go put toward their rent. It's a win-win situation. I believe that when God blesses us, we can then be a blessing to others.

How do you keep spiritually fed now?

I fellowship at another church called Christian World, and I also go to St Michael's with my wife. But most importantly, I'm on my knees every morning in my private prayer time, letting the Lord equip me for battle in the war zone of the spiritual war that's going on on the streets.

There's someone reading this that might be at rock bottom. What words do you have for them?

Nothing – I mean NOTHING – could have caused me to progress in my life without forgiveness. I asked God for forgiveness, and He forgave me. I asked others for forgiveness. And I had to forgive myself. It's ALL about

forgiveness.

I am the Prodigal Son that has come home! And now it's my purpose to reach out and help others who are ready to change their lives. I'm not perfect, but I just want to do what I can to let other people know that if God can change me... trust me he can change anybody!

So I would say, "GET UP! STAY UP!" And then go help someone else up.

Thank you, Ronnie, for sharing your story and for your service to our community.

Antes Sin Hogar Ahora Sirviendo Fielmente

La historia sagrada de Ronnie Forbes



Cualquier persona que llegue a conocer a Ronnie percibe instantáneamente su entusiasmo por el Señor y su pasión insaciable por ayudar a las personas necesitadas. Su despensa móvil de alimentos para veteranos "One Nation Dreammakers" ha proporcionado cientos de libras de alimentos gratuitos de alta calidad en más de 10 ciudades semanalmente, pero el mejor regalo es su espíritu y su risa contagiosa.

Pero no siempre fue así. Aquí está su SacredStory:

Gracias por compartir su historia, Ronnie. Cuéntenos un poco sobre su vida.

Me crie en el sur de California en un hogar religioso, predominantemente sin denominación específica. Mi mamá y mi papá son co-pastores de Riverside Christian Family Fellowship, de modo que se puede decir que tuve una educación bastante estricta. Justo después de terminar la escuela secundaria empecé a estudiar en UC Irvine y empecé a alejarme del Señor y de los valores impartidos en mi crianza. Me involucré en un estilo de vida en la que hacía lo que ya sabía que no debería hacer. Llegó un momento en que quise buscar una nueva vida de sobriedad y decidí mudarme al norte de California y vivir con mi abuela; pero no funcionó; empecé nuevamente a usar

substancias y a salir con un grupo de personas equivocadas. Entonces me quedaron dos opciones: unirme al Departamento de Policía de Oakland o al Ejército de los Estados Unidos. Elegí unirme al ejército.

¿Y el ejército le enderezó su vida?

No, toda la gloria es para Dios y su paciencia conmigo. Fui a prestar servicio en Corea con esperanzas y aspiraciones de hacer una carrera en el ejército hasta jubilarme; allá conocí a una mujer coreana, me enamoré de ella y nos casamos, pero luego ocurrieron muchas cosas que me causaron un profundo dolor y trauma. Sin entrar en muchos detalles, a un hombre negro casado con una coreana no se le trata igual que si fuese un hombre blanco casado con una coreana. Sin embargo, me quedé en Corea durante tres años antes de traerla a casa, pero también traje conmigo el alcohol y las drogas que nunca dejé de usar durante mi tiempo de servicio en el ejército para automedicar mi PTSD. No había perdonado ni a los militares ni a mí mismo por todas las cosas que había hecho; estaba descendiendo rápidamente. Le eché la culpa a Dios y a los militares, seguí bebiendo y consumiendo drogas y perdí mi matrimonio. Abandoné a mi esposa, rechacé todo el apoyo de mi familia y terminé en las calles de Oakland y Hayward, sin hogar. Me la pasaba todo el tiempo con la gente equivocada y entrando y saliendo de la cárcel.

Muchas personas dicen frecuentemente que esa es una situación muy desesperada. ¿Cómo fue que ocurrió el cambio para Ud.?

Mi momento de claridad ocurrió durante mi último encarcelamiento. Escuché la voz de Dios diciéndome: "Mira, o me sirves detrás de estos muros o fuera de ellos, pero ciertamente me servirás". Eso no lo olvidaré nunca pues me inició en mi camino de rehabilitación. En busca de la sobriedad me mudé a Livermore, sin saber nada sobre el área de Tri-Valley, pero siempre seguía pensando en el mensaje que Dios me había enviado hasta que llegó un momento en que supe que El me llamaba para ayudar a los veteranos.

El Señor también te estaba llamando para ayudarte, ¿verdad?

Si. Me entregué totalmente a Jesús el día 4 de julio de 2015; ¡Se puede decir que verdaderamente es el Día de la Independencia! Conseguí ayuda de consejería profesional y ayuda médica, para ayudar con la rehabilitación física. Este arduo trabajo de rehabilitación, unido a la gracia de Dios, hizo la gran diferencia. Y luego Dios puso en mi camino a mi ángel de la guarda, una nueva persona en mi vida, mi bella esposa quien es católica, asiste a la parroquia de St. Michael's y es mi presentadora.

¿En qué le ayudó su conexión con St. Michael?

Realmente comencé a sentir al Espíritu Santo en la hermandad que existe en St. Michael's. Todo comenzó a suceder muy rápidamente, conociendo a muchas personas y recibiendo apoyo de ellas; los cambios en mi vida sucedieron con todas esas personas con las que me conecté en la parroquia de St. Michael's. Por eso yo siempre digo que St. Michael's es mi sede central. Y ahí es donde el programa de despensa de alimentos para veteranos alcanzó otro nivel.

¿Fue entonces cuando se fundó "One Nation Dream Makers"?

Sí, me había unido a otros veteranos que luchaban igual que yo y estoy seguro que el Espíritu Santo siguió abriéndome las puertas. Formé una organización llamada "One Nation Dream Makers" para ayudar a los veteranos y a las personas menos afortunadas a volver a encontrar el camino correcto y convertirse en influencias positivas en sus familias y comunidades. Trabajando en asociación con el programa "St. Michael's Community Care" y otras agencias y organizaciones, comenzamos a proporcionar semanalmente cientos de libras de alimentos gratuitos de alta calidad en más de 10 ciudades; entregamos los alimentos directamente en viviendas para personas de bajos ingresos, viviendas del gobierno, escuelas, iglesias y centros para personas mayores en toda el Área de la Bahía. Semanalmente entregamos alrededor de 1.295 cajas, cada una con 35 libras de carne, queso, leche, frutas, verduras y pasta, lo suficiente para alimentar a una familia de cuatro por una semana.

¡Eso es dar una vuelta completa!

Estoy muy contento de poder servir a otros, entrego alimento en los mismos lugares donde yo los recibía cuando era un veterano sin hogar, hambriento y haciendo las mismas



filas; eso simplemente me da más motivación para seguir ayudando. Si estas personas reciben alimentos gratuitos ya no tienen que comprarlos y puede utilizar ese dinero para pagar la factura de la luz o para pagar el alquiler. Es una situación en la que todos ganan. Creo que cuando Dios nos bendice, nosotros podemos ser una bendición para otros.

¿Y ahora, cómo se alimenta Ud. espiritualmente?

Participo en otra iglesia llamada Christian World, y también en St. Michael's con mi esposa. Pero lo más importante es que todas las mañanas me hinco de rodillas ante el Señor para que me prepare para la batalla en el campo de guerra espiritual que se libra diariamente en las calles.

¿Qué le diría Ud. a alguien que se siente desesperado, si esa persona estuviera leyendo su historia?

Sin el perdón yo no hubiera podido hacer nada, absolutamente NADA. Le pedí perdón a Dios y Él me perdonó, le pedí perdón a otros y tuve


también que perdonarme a mí mismo. TODO tiene que ver con el perdón.

¡Soy el hijo pródigo que ha vuelto a casa! Y ahora mi propósito es extender la mano y ayudar a otras personas que están listas para cambiar sus vidas. ¡No soy perfecto, pero solo quiero hacer lo que esté a mi alcance para que otras personas sepan que si Dios pudo cambiarme a mí...sepan con confianza que Él puede cambiar a cualquiera! Entonces yo diría, "¡LEVANTATE Y QUEDATE PARADO!".... Y luego, ve y ayuda a otro a levantarse.

Ronnie, muchas gracias por compartir su historia y por su servicio a nuestra comunidad.
