# A Little Spark Changed Jackie Forever

Jackie Le's #SacredStory

Jackie had a rough childhood when she moved to the US from Vietnam, and she resented everything. She secretly didn't believe that God existed. But then one quiet moment at her Confirmation retreat, she felt a little spark in her soul that changed ... everything!

Here's her SacredStory:

## Jackie, what was it like for you growing up?

I wasn't born in the US actually. I was born in Vietnam, and I immigrated to the US when I was about three years old or so. Religion wise, I was really Catholic. My family are all really seriously Catholic, like never-something-to-joke-about kind of Catholics. But I went through a pretty weird childhood. My parents are first generation immigrants, and they work seven days a week. Total workaholics. When I got to the US, I had an accent and didn't speak English very well. My dad's side of the family treated me and my mom badly. I was bullied at school, bullied at home, bullied by my babysitter. I just started resenting everything, and I didn't really like life at all. So at around 5th, 6th, 7th grade until all the way to sophomore year of high school, I declared myself as an atheist.

## Wait, how did you decide to be atheist in such a Catholic family?

I know, I know, I know! You're going to think I'm crazy! I didn't tell my family though, but on the inside, I was one of those people who was all, "God isn't real blah blah blah." The funny thing is, I still went to Mass, I still went to Faith Formation and Confirmation classes.

I remember telling my mom – like somewhere in my freshman year of high school - that sometimes I don't think God is real. And then being the really Catholic mom that she is, well she kind of flipped out [laughing]. She was all, "We should take you to a priest! You should have a conversation with him!" But I told her, "If you ever bring me in to talk to a priest, I am not going to tell you anything ever again!"

It's just so weird, because people think of me now as this cute bubbly little Catholic girl, but I wasn't always like that. I was just going through the motions during those years, still thinking God wasn't a thing, until I went to the overnight Confirmation retreat.

## Really? What happened there?

See that's just it. It wasn't a huge thing. It wasn't the stories, or the fun and games or praying together. No one whispered in my ear, and I didn't have this big vision or anything. Nothing big or epic happened. But I just felt something inside my soul. I

just felt it. Like this teeny, little spark, this little ... I don't know, difference? I just started crying for no reason, and I was like what's going on? I promised myself that when I graduated and moved out, I would never set foot inside a church again. But in that moment, about two years ago I became... different. Something really shifted. It made me think about what I was feeling inside and I thought, "Hey, is that really Jesus? Is that really You knocking at my door?" I thought to myself that maybe I should take this Jesus guy a little more seriously! [laughing].

## Wow, that actually sounds bigger than you think! What did you do next?

Well, I started taking my religion seriously, and I started becoming like a "real Catholic". I started being aware and present at Mass and in prayer. I mean, from the outside I probably didn't look any different. I was doing the same things – going to church every Sunday and stuff - but that one little moment at the retreat changed me on the inside. So, I started listening in Mass more, you know? I started going to choir practice and really got into it in a different away.

## Did it change your outlook, this new awareness of God?

Yeah, it made me look back at past events with new eyes. I noticed in a

new way that when I was in 6th grade, I moved to Livermore and got away from my dad's side of the family, and things got a little better. I met people at St Michael's and made some really great friends. People were treating me nicer and then everyone around me started loving me. So now "post spark" I think it is God is showing me that things get better with time, and that there might be down times, but it's not the worst ever. I mean while I was experiencing it, it was awful, but looking back I can see that my life is pretty good. I can see how far my family and I have come. My parents are more financially stable, I have good friends, I got away from toxic relationships, my schoolwork is better, and I can just balance it all better. And I just graduated from high school! It's like I can see now that God has a plan for me. It's a pretty good life!

### You're involved in singing with the St Michael Music Ministry and volunteering at Community Care now?

Yes! I originally joined the music ministry four years ago, and it was honestly only because I was trying to wrap up some service hours for my Confirmation. As I mentioned earlier, I didn't really think God existed then, and I only came sometimes, so I never really felt a connection. I was just going through the motions. But then after that retreat and "The Spark" [laughing], I was singing my heart out! Like I really got so into it that time flew and felt like only 10 minutes, but it had been over an hour. It's like that spark just got a little bigger when I sang, and I was praying through song.

Then at St Michael Community Care, I had to do 75 or 100 hours of community service for school. Again, it was just like one more thing to just get done for the hours. I volunteered to help on the Traffic Team, and my job is to greet people at their cars

and get some basic information from them like how many boxes of food they need. After a while, I noticed that it is so cool to talk to people and greet them warmly, because they just need a little help. Some people feel embarrassed or awkward. I like just being friendly and putting them at ease, you know? I see some regulars now who recognize me, so it's

pretty awesome. Anyway, so I kept coming back even after I got all my hours done.

### Now that you've graduated from high school, what's your next step?

I'm sticking around Livermore a little longer, going to go to Las Positas. And maybe even after that, I might commute to maybe Santa Clara or something. So I'm happy to keep my volunteer ministries at St Michael's going. I mean, even though I grew up Catholic, I'm in a lot of ways a "newbie". And I want to make sure I

can balance school and faith life too.

### What would you say to someone who is in a rough spot?

Well, first, you know you hear all these crazy stories about how people became Christian or found Jesus or God healed them or something. You know these really, really BIG things. And it is true that God can do the big stuff, but at least in my life it was more of little quiet subtle things that changed me. That one little moment at the retreat. Then it's other little things like waking up in the morning with a new positive outlook that maybe wasn't there before. Or maybe it's just a random guy who smiles at you and it makes your day a little better. Most of the time it's the smallest things that just start to pile up to be bigger things and before you know it, you're just different. Better! I think God likes moving little things!


### What do you hope for next?

I don't know, but maybe when I'm working at Community Care and someone needs groceries, I'd like to think that maybe I'm the smiling face that they needed to see. Or when I'm singing, maybe someone who was too shy to sing decides to sing along with me. And it's okay if I never know about it! I just want to be part of the plan. I just want to trust in the Lord's ripple effects, you know? I think the rest will just follow.

# Una Chispita Cambió a Jackie Para Siempre

La historia sagrada de Jackie Le

Después de mudarse de Vietnam a los EE.UU. Jackie tuvo una infancia difícil y estaba resentida con todo. En sus pensamientos ella dudaba de la existencia de Dios hasta que, en un momento de tranquilidad en su retiro de Confirmación, sintió una pequeña chispa en su alma que le cambió toda su vida. Aquí está su SacredStory:

## Jackie, ¿cómo fue tu niñez?

En realidad, nací en Vietnam y emigré a los Estados Unidos cuando tenía como unos tres años. En cuanto a la religión, yo era católica porque vengo de una familia que toma la religión muy en serio, de la clase de católicos que nunca bromean con eso. Tuve una infancia bastante extraña; mis padres son inmigrantes de la primera generación y trabajan los siete días de la semana. Totalmente adictos al trabajo. Cuando llegué a los Estados Unidos yo no hablaba bien el inglés y tenía acento. La familia paterna nos trató mal, tanto a mi mamá como a mí y fui intimidada en la escuela, en casa, y por mi niñera y empecé a resentirme por todo y realmente no me gustaba la vida en absoluto. Entonces, alrededor del quinto, sexto, séptimo grado hasta el segundo año de la escuela secundaria, me declaré atea.

## Espera, ¿cómo fue que decidiste ser atea en una familia tan católica?

¡Lo sé, lo sé, lo sé; pensarás que estoy loca! Sin embargo, no le dije nada a mi familia, pero por dentro, yo era una de esas personas que decía: "Dios no es real, bla, bla, bla". Lo curioso es que todavía iba a misa, y asistí a las clases de formación en la fe y confirmación.

Recuerdo que en mi primer año de secundaria le dije a mi madre que a veces yo no creía que Dios existiera. Y bueno, ella, siendo tan católica como es, pues le dio un ataque [risas....] y me dijo, "deberíamos de llevarte a un sacerdote para que hables con él" y yo le contesté: "Si me llevas, jamás te volveré a contar nada."

Todo es como tan raro, porque ahora la gente piensa que soy una muchachita católica muy alegre; pero no siempre fui así; en esos años yo fingía creer en Dios, pero en realidad yo pensaba que Dios no existía hasta que asistí al retiro de la Confirmación.

## ¿En serio? ¿Qué pasó allí?

Mira, esa es la cosa; no pasó nada grande, ni las historias, ni la diversión y los juegos, ni el rezar juntos. Nadie me susurró al oído y no tuve esta gran visión ni nada. No pasó nada grande o épico. Pero algo sentí dentro de mi alma; simplemente lo sentí. Como una chispa pequeña, pequeñita, fue una pequeña ... no sé qué decirte, una pequeña

¿diferencia? Empecé a llorar sin motivo y pensé, ¿qué me está pasando? Me prometí a mí misma que cuando me graduara y me mudara jamás volvería a poner un pie en una iglesia. Pero de repente, hace unos dos años, algo realmente cambió en mí y me volví una persona ... diferente. Empecé a pensar en lo que estaba sintiendo dentro de mí y me pregunté: "Oye, ¿Realmente, será Jesús el que está llamando a mi puerta? Se me ocurrió que tal vez debería de tomar más en serio a este hombre, a Jesús [risas....].

## ¡Vaya! Esto suena más grande de lo que piensas, ¿Qué hiciste después?

Bueno, empecé a tomar mi religión en serio y a convertirme en una "verdadera católica". Ahora estaba más consciente y presente en la Misa y en la oración. Quiero decir, externamente no había diferencia, estaba haciendo lo mismo, ir a la iglesia todos los domingos y esas cosas, pero ese pequeño momento en el retiro me cambió por dentro. Desde entonces, comencé a prestar atención en la misa, ¿sabes? Empecé a ir a la práctica del coro y me fui involucrando de una manera diferente.

## Esta nueva conciencia de la presencia de Dios, ¿te cambio tu percepción de la vida?

Sí, me hizo mirar hacia atrás, mirar con nuevos ojos a los sucesos del pasado. Por ejemplo, recordé que

cuando estaba en sexto grado, me mudé a Livermore, me alejé de la familia de mi padre, y las cosas mejoraron un poco; conocí gente en la parroquia de St. Michael's e hice muy buenos amigos. La gente me trataba mejor y luego todos a mi alrededor comenzaron a tenerme cariño. De manera que ahora, "después de la chispa", yo creo que Dios me está mostrando que las cosas cambian y mejoran con el tiempo y que, aunque se viven momentos difíciles, eso no es lo peor que pudiera pasar. Y aunque en el momento en que estamos pasando por dificultades uno siente que las cosas son horribles, pero luego, al mirar hacia atrás me di cuenta de que mi vida es bastante buena. Puedo ver lo que hemos logrado hacer, tanto mi familia como yo. Mis padres están financieramente establecidos, tengo buenos amigos, me he alejado de las relaciones tóxicas, mi trabajo escolar ha mejorado y puedo equilibrarlo todo mejor. Ahora veo que Dios tiene un plan para mí y que mi vida es una vida bastante buena. ¡Y eso que apenas acabo de graduarme de la escuela secundaria!

### **¿Y ahora estás involucrada en el Ministerio de Música y eres voluntaria en el programa de Community Care de la parroquia de St. Michael?**

¡Sí! Primeramente, me uní al ministerio de música hace cuatro años, y honestamente lo hice solamente porque estaba tratando de completar las horas de servicio comunitario requeridos para la Confirmación. Como ya mencioné anteriormente, en ese entonces yo realmente no creía en la existencia de Dios y solo iba algunas veces al programa, así que nunca sentí una conexión, solo cumplía con la rutina. Pero luego, después del retiro y de "la Chispita" [risas...], yo cantaba con todo mi corazón y el tiempo se me pasaba volando, estaba tan entregada que parecía que habían pasado solo como 10 minutos cuando había pasado más de una hora. Era como si esa

chispita se hacía un poco más grande cuando cantaba y oraba a través de la canción.

Luego, para cumplir con el requisito de 75 o 100 horas de servicio comunitario para la escuela me uní al programa de Community Care en la parroquia de St. Michael's; lo hice solamente para acumular las horas que



necesitaba. Me asignaron a saludar a las personas que llegan en sus autos a recibir alimentos gratuitos y obtener información básica de ellos, por ejemplo, cuántas cajas de comida necesitan. Después de un tiempo, me llegó a gustar mucho hablar con la gente y saludarlos afectuosamente, porque ellos a veces necesitan solamente un poco de ayuda para salir adelante, pero se sienten avergonzadas o incómodas por recibir los alimentos y a mí me gusta platicar amablemente con ellos y hacer que se sientan mejor, ¿sabes? Ahora veo a algunas personas que llegan habitualmente y me reconocen y me saludan, es impresionante. Por eso, después de terminar las horas requeridas, seguí regresando a ayudar en el programa.

### **Ahora que te graduaste de la escuela secundaria, ¿cuál es tu próximo paso?**

Me quedaré un tiempo más en Livermore, primero voy a ir a Las Positas College y quizás después podría viajar tal vez a Santa Clara o algo así. Por lo pronto, estoy feliz de poder

continuar con mis ministerios de voluntariado en St. Michael. Quiero decir que, aunque crecí como católica, en muchos sentidos soy "novata". Y también quiero asegurarme de poder equilibrar la escuela y la vida religiosa.

### **¿Qué le dirías a alguien que se encuentra en una situación difícil?**

Bueno, a veces uno escucha historias extraordinarias sobre la conversión de personas al cristianismo, o como encontraron a Jesús, o como Dios los sanó y cosas así. Estas historias son realmente GRANDES y es muy cierto que Dios todo lo puede; sin embargo, los cambios en mi vida fueron a través de cosas pequeñas y sutiles. Ese pequeño momento en el retiro y otras pequeñas cosas en la vida como despertarse por la mañana con una nueva perspectiva positiva que tal vez antes no existía, quizás alguien te sonríe haciendo que tu día sea un poco mejor. La mayoría de las veces son las cosas más pequeñas las que comienzan a acumularse para convertirse en cosas más grandes y, antes de que te des cuenta, eres diferente. ¡Mejor! ¡Creo que a Dios le gusta mover pequeñas cosas!

### **¿Qué esperas que suceda después?**

No lo sé, pero cuando estoy trabajando en Community Care y alguien necesita alimentos, me gusta pensar que tal vez sea yo la cara sonriente que necesitan ver en ese momento. O cuando estoy cantando, quizás hay alguien que es muy tímido para cantar, pero decide cantar conmigo. Nunca lo sabré, pero no importa porque yo solo quiero ser parte del plan. Solo quiero confiar que el Señor multiplicará estos sentimientos ¿sabes? Y creo que el resto vendrá después.

### **Jackie, ¡eres increíble! ¡Gracias por compartir tu historia!**

De nada. ¡Estoy feliz de que finalmente puedo contarla!
