GOSPEL REFLECTIONS



St. Thomas Aquinas reminds us that, "Three things are necessary for the salvation of man: to know what he ought to believe, to know what he ought to desire, and to know what he ought to do."

Everyone is called to work toward their salvation, which is ultimately union with God. Those who take this call seriously must embark upon a journey inward to the deepest recesses of their soul. In the adventure and wonder of that journey, we work out the details of our union with our Beloved. We cling to what we need to believe, remain firm in what we truly desire, and are guided by what we know we have to do. Once we know that our goal is to be one with our Creator, life becomes an exciting expedition to pursue that end. We make necessary preparations, follow the map, and remain on course.

Whenever we really want something, we put our entire selves into achieving it. Being fully invested in our labor, we willingly work extra hours, devote an abundance of energy and effort, and remain vigilant for beneficial opportunities that may come our way. We certainly do not passively

sit by doing nothing! Such an attitude leads to laziness and the accomplishment of little. Worse yet, some look to others to do the work for them, hoping to reap the benefits of another's efforts. Conscientiousness and diligence are the only means to success.

For the one who eagerly awaits the day when they can be fully with God, life becomes a joyous adventure indeed! Alert, ready, focused, convicted, and willing to be a servant they constantly watch and prepare themselves for meeting the Lord. Loving the journey and being in love with their Creator, their lives become joyful witnesses of love and service. They are secure in their hope, confident in their faith, and perfect in their love. Never looking for recognition or gratitude, they stand as gentle inspirations of what the Holy Spirit can do in the hearts of those who believe. 

CAUGHT IN THE RISING ACTION

Think of some of your favorite iconic movies. I'm not talking about the feel-good comedies or the offbeat coming-of-age flicks. I'm talking about the movies that you found had a profound impact on you or made you go "Hmmm."

I'm willing to bet that the plot of this film features some tough moments and difficult scenarios. However happy the ending, at some point, the situation for the protagonist might look awfully hopeless. The script speaks some truth to you about what it is to be human in difficult circumstances. What it means to persevere.

We're attracted to the tension that exists when the hero is besieged. We're captivated by the decisions he makes in the darkest hour of the night when it seems like the dawn will never come. Why? Because we know that feeling so well. This is the

essence of our human life on earth: waiting, hoping, doubting — and enduring.

We know the ending to our story, but we don't know when it's coming. We live our whole lives in the rising action of the narrative. Sure, it gets old. Tiresome, even dull. We may start to despair that the climactic scene is coming at all.

But faith is the realization of things hoped for, and evidence of things not seen. We feel it watching a great movie, because we recognize it intuitively: it is faith which earns the happy ending. No one is drawn to the story when the hero gives up or gets tired of waiting for the payoff. Everyday stewardship is the collection of choices we make while we're waiting, because we are called to action, not idleness, even in our perpetual state of expectation.


Gospel:

La clave es estar preparados para no ser sorprendidos sin haber completado la labor encomendada por Dios. "Tengan puesta la ropa de trabajo y sus lámparas encendidas. Sean como personas que esperan que su patrón regrese de la boda para abrirle apenas llegue y golpee a la puerta" (Lucas 12,35-36).

El Evangelio nos habla de cómo ser unos administradores que cuidan los bienes de su Señor. No podemos ser sordos del cuidado de unos para con otros, del compromiso de velar por nuestra casa común: "el mundo". Todos tenemos algo o alguien bajo nuestro cuidado, la familia, el jardín, la calle, la escuela, etcétera. Por ejemplo, ¿cómo te cuidaste y

cuidaste de otros durante la pandemia? ¿Qué aprendiste de todo esto que vivimos a nivel mundial? El Señor nos pide estar siempre en vela, cuidadosos para estar bien despiertos, cuando llegue a pedir cuentas. Y ese día llegará: "Al que mucho se le dio, mucho se le exigirá; al que mucho se le confió, más se le exigirá" (Lucas 12,48). ¡Ánimo, todo se puede con fe! No es cuestión de susto. Es cosa de entrega y solidez con cimientos fundados en nuestra experiencia y deseo de Dios. "Este es un aspecto fundamental de la vida. Estoy dispuesto a apostar que la trama de esta película presenta algunos momentos duros y escenarios difíciles. Por muy feliz que sea el final, en algún momento, la situación para el protagonista puede parecer terriblemente desesperada. El guión te dice algo de verdad sobre lo que es ser humano en circunstancias difíciles. Lo que significa perseverar.

Nos atrae la tensión que existe cuando el héroe es asediado. Nos cautivan las decisiones que toma en la hora más oscura de la noche cuando parece que nunca llegará el amanecer. ¿Por qué? Porque conocemos muy bien ese sentimiento. Esta es la esencia de nuestra vida humana en la tierra: esperar, esperanzar, dudar y resistir. Conocemos el final de nuestra historia, pero no sabemos cuándo llegará.

Vivimos toda nuestra vida en la acción creciente de la narración. Claro, pasa de moda. Fastidiosa, incluso aburrida. Podemos comenzar a desesperarnos pensando si la escena culminante llegara.

Pero la fe es la realización de las cosas que se esperan, y la evidencia de las cosas que no se ven. Lo sentimos viendo una gran película, porque lo reconocemos intuitivamente: es la fe la que gana el final feliz. Nadie se siente atraído por la historia cuando el héroe se da por vencido o se cansa de esperar la recompensa. La responsabilidad diaria es el conjunto de elecciones que hacemos mientras esperamos, porque estamos llamados a la acción, no a la ociosidad, incluso en nuestro estado perpetuo de expectativa.



It is with a sense of loss that I announce that Eric Hom will leave his position as Director of Business Operations at St Michael to serve on the Executive Leadership Team at CityServe Tri Valley.

Eric joined St Michael on December 26, 2016. As our Director of Business Operations, Eric worked behind-the-scenes streamlining processes and procedures to create a strong structure for running our very large parish. He solidified teams, empowered volunteer councils, and elevated a culture of cooperation within our parish and with the greater Tri-Valley area. Because of that foundation, our parish was able to navigate the difficult months without a pastor. He also led the completion of a \$1.5 million renovation project of the parish hall and expanded numerous programs that have re-ignited our community. Thanks in part to his leadership, St Michael increased net operating income 8%-10% each year, including in 2020 during the height of the pandemic. We have been blessed to have Eric steering the operations of our parish through both tumultuous and joyous times.

Eric, his wife Loremae, and his daughters, Madison and Melanie will remain faithful parishioners, so we will still enjoy their company! Eric will continue serving on the St Michael School Board.

Please join with me in offering prayers of thanksgiving for Eric's service, for strength for him as he begins his new journey, and for the entire Hom family.

Eric se unió al personal de St. Michael el 26 de diciembre de 2016 como Director de Operaciones Comerciales. En esa capacidad, Eric trabajó entre bastidores simplificando los procesos y procedimientos para crear una estructura administrativa sólida para manejar nuestra parroquia, que es bastante grande. Solidificó equipos, fortaleció los comités de voluntarios y promovió una cultura de cooperación tanto dentro de nuestra propia estructura parroquial como con el área metropolitana de Tri-Valley. Gracias a esa sólida base, pudimos atravesar los meses difíciles sin tener un párroco; también dirigió la finalización de un proyecto de renovación de \$1.5 millones del salón parroquial y amplió numerosos programas que han reavivado nuestra comunidad. St. Michael logró aumentar los ingresos operativos netos entre un 8 % y un 10 % cada año, incluso en 2020 durante la cúspide de la pandemia gracias, en parte, al liderazgo de Eric. Hemos tenido la bendición de tener a Eric dirigiendo las operaciones de nuestra parroquia en tiempos tumultuosos y alegres.

Eric, su esposa Loremae y sus hijas, Madison y Melanie seguirán siendo fieles feligreses de nuestra parroquia; de modo que seguiremos disfrutando de su compañía; Eric continuará prestando servicio en la Junta Escolar de St. Michael.
