GOSPEL REFLECTIONS



Since God created human beings, we have struggled to keep our focus on God. We wrestle with the question of "who is God" and foolishly believe some of God's job description can be better completed by us. We wander in different directions, lose our way, think that happiness can be found elsewhere and even construct golden calves to worship. Are we simply too independent or just blatantly stubborn? It's a good question to ask. Even with all of our silliness and distractions, God compassionately and patiently waits. He lets us assert our wills and knows that perhaps one day we will actually wake up and realize how lost we are.

"Since happiness is nothing other than the enjoyment of the highest good and since the highest good is above, no one can be made happy unless he rises above himself, not by an ascent of the body but of the heart. But we cannot rise above ourselves unless a higher power lifts us up ... Divine aid is available to those who seek it from their hearts, humbly and devoutly; and this means to sigh for it in this valley of tears, through fervent prayer (St. Bonaventure)." One of the biggest human struggles is

discerning what, exactly, is the highest good. We are ordered to achieve it but if we pursue it with clouded vision, we will never truly find it.

One of the greatest obstacles to God's power and love is a stubborn, closed heart of stone. When we are fiercely determined to set our sights elsewhere for happiness or simply ride the popular currents of the day, we will never satisfy the deep ache and longing within. We know that ache well. It is precisely why we scurry all over the place, attempting to find the next best thing to take away its pain. Nothing in the created world ever can or will. We continue our journey. One day, people may wake up and realize that they are grazing in the wrong pasture and putting themselves in harm's way. When this awakening occurs, it will be a most joyous day as we will see God's wide-open arms waiting to receive us. "Lead me, Lord, in your path, and I will enter in your truth. Let my heart rejoice that it may fear your name (St. Bonaventure)."

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO



En cada uno de los domingos pasados, la Palabra de Dios nos invitaba a ser mejores seguidores de Jesús. La liturgia de hoy no se queda atrás, hay que seguir con mucho entusiasmo y fidelidad su enseñanza. Atrévete, nos dirá el Señor, levántate y ponte en camino hacia el Padre. El Papa Francisco en sus excelentes catequesis nos exhorta a lo siguiente: "Dios espera siempre que reanudemos el viaje, nos espera con paciencia, nos ve cuando todavía estamos lejos, sale a nuestro encuentro, nos abraza, nos besa, nos perdona. ¡Así es Dios! ¡Así es nuestro Padre! Y su perdón borra el pasado y nos regenera en el amor".

¿Has experimentado el perdón de Dios? Me imagino que sí. Porque si has perdonado a alguien que te ha ofendido, de seguro que has gozado del perdón de Dios en tu vida. El Evangelio, en este domingo, es rico en alegría y

perdón. Las cien ovejas y la búsqueda de una sola que estaba perdida: "Alérgense conmigo, porque he encontrado la oveja que se me había perdido" (Lucas 15,6). La mujer que pierde una moneda de las diez que tiene, y su alegría de encontrarla: "Alérgense conmigo, porque hallé la moneda que se me había perdido" (Lucas 15,9). Estas dos parábolas indican la iniciativa de Dios, quien busca, encuentra y se alegra. En la tercera parábola, la del hijo pródigo, la iniciativa de Dios se basa en la libertad y el respeto por el ser humano.

FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS

Offertory collections exceeded budget by 3%

Total income exceeded budget due to donations to the Community Care program and church, as well as one-time PPP loan forgiveness

Overall expenses were reduced 5% vs. 2020, while slightly exceeding budget by 3%

GROCERIES DISTRIBUTED THROUGH COMMUNITY CARE

Raised over \$50K in donations in 2021 which has funded weekly food donations for community members in need.



RISE, AND GO TO YOUR FATHER

"If you pull into my driveway and honk, you better be dropping off a package, because you're sure not picking anything up."

I first read these words in the pages of W. Bruce Cameron's "8 Simple Rules for Dating my Teenage Daughter," (that's Rule No. 5, by the way). There's a certain respect that is shown by someone who takes the time to come to the door, ring the bell and wait to be greeted. Being willing to go through the niceties for the sake of appearances is a small act of deference on the part of the person doing the picking-up, even if it's not for a date. Without it, the whole scenario becomes entitled.

I want you to think of something that you want or need, but do not have. Is it peace? Is it financial stability? Is it strength? Is it friendship?

The brother of the prodigal son had a lot of unexpressed desires. He sees his brother heaped with gifts and favors, feasting on the fattened calf, and he is enraged. I haven't been given half of that, he thinks, and I've worked so hard. But for all his faithfulness, one has to wonder — did this son ever simply ask for what he needed? Did he get out of the car, so to speak, and ring the bell? Or did he sit in the driveway leaning on the horn?

God wants us to come before Him. He wants us to ask. He wants us to be like Moses — sure enough of our Father's indulgence to boldly ask for it. Think again about what you need but do not have, and ask yourself: Have I approached the door and rung the bell?

Leí estas palabras por primera vez en las páginas de "8 Reglas Simples para Salir con mi Hija Adolescente" de W. Bruce Cameron (esa es la regla número 5, por cierto).

Hay un cierto respeto que muestra alguien que se toma el tiempo de llegar a la puerta, tocar el timbre y esperar a que lo saluden. Estar dispuesto a pasar por las sutilezas por el bien de las apariencias es un pequeño acto de deferencia por parte de la persona que recoge, incluso si no es para una cita. Sin ello, todo el escenario se convierte en presunción.

Quiero que pienses en algo que quieres o necesitas, pero no tienes. ¿Es paz?

¿Es la estabilidad financiera? ¿Es fortaleza? ¿Es amistad?

El hermano del hijo pródigo tenía muchos deseos no expresados. Ve a su hermano colmado de regalos y favores, festejando con el becerro engordado, y se enfurece. No me han dado ni la mitad de eso, piensa, y he trabajado muy duro. Pero a pesar de toda su fidelidad, uno tiene que preguntarse: ¿Este hijo alguna vez simplemente pidió lo que necesitaba? ¿Se bajó del coche, por así decirlo, y tocó el timbre? ¿O se sentó en el camino de entrada apoyado en la bocina?

Dios quiere que nos acerquemos a Él. Él quiere que preguntemos. Él quiere que seamos como Moisés, lo suficientemente seguros de la indulgencia de nuestro Padre para pedirla con valentía. Piensa de nuevo en lo que necesitas pero no tienes, y pregúntate: ¿Me he acercado a la puerta y he tocado el timbre?
