Tasks of Catechesis

Education and formation require attention to the whole person. Faith formation must stretch beyond just the transmitting of information. We must seek to engage each person in their journey of discovering who Jesus Christ is and God's plan for their life. Assisting them to develop a habit of practicing the Faith and living it authentically is also important.

The Six Fundamental Tasks of Catechesis

The General Directory for Catechesis specifies the six tasks of catechesis:

- Catechesis promotes knowledge of the faith.

The Six Fundamental Tasks of Catechesis

The General Directory for Catechesis specifies the six tasks of catechesis:

- Catechesis teaches the Christian how to pray with Christ.
 Pray with your teen, do the assigned faith sharing projects/family movie nights with them ~ Prayer Book
- 5. Catechesis prepares the Christian to live in community and to participate actively in the life and mission of the Church.

Bring money contribution to support the work and mission of the Church

6. Catechesis promotes a missionary spirit that prepares the faithful to be present as Christians in society.


Expectations for Families in Faith Formation
